As I drive around the municipality, this time of year always reminds me of how lucky we all are to live in such a beautiful place. The Benalla Botanical Gardens and our parklands are at their best. Out of town, the farmland is also a sight to behold, the paddocks look great with the spring growth.

You may have noticed that we've taken advantage of the recent dry weather to make significant progress on the construction of the 1.3 kilometre section of the Winton Wetlands shared pathway along Sydney Road to the inlet channel car park.

This bike path is part of a much larger project across the whole of north-east Victoria that will provide bike paths and a cycle network that will eventually go all the way from the Murray to the Mountains.

The link from the Mokoan Hub to Glenrowan will be an important addition for Benalla and Wangaratta.



This new section of bike path beside Sydney Road is being developed in partnership with the Winton Wetlands Committee of Management and will eventually go all the way to the Wetlands entrance on Nelson Road.

This bike path is part of a much larger project across the whole of north-east Victoria that will provide bike paths and a cycle network that will eventually link to the Murray to the Mountains pathway. The bike path will also be great for families and local people who choose to ride, rather than drive out to the Wetlands.
