Benalla Art Gallery


Planned reopening from 10 July

Gutters and Outdoor Open Spaces included in the Council Plan

The 2017 - 2021 Council Plan (2020 Review) was adopted by the Council on Wednesday 24 June.

There are two important inclusions in the 2020 Review. An Open Space Strategic Plan will guide how we develop our valuable open spaces, such as playgrounds, landscaping and walking tracks into the future. A Central Business District Gutter Strategy will determine what work can be done to modify our deep gutters to address safety and drainage issues.



Works around Benalla Rural City

We've completed routine bridge maintenance across our rural townships and repaired drains and culverts.

We've been removing leaves and debris from Benalla's streets. We've also been working on footpath maintenance on Goomalibee Street and Cowan Street. We've installed new flushing mechanisms in the Denny Street toilets and completed works on the Benalla Airport, sealing cracks and respraying markings on the runways.



Aquatic Centre refreshed

Since the Benalla Aquatic Centre closed on 23 March, we've used this time to repair and repaint the walls inside the venue and to retile and finish the changerooms.

We are also retiling the shell of the 25m pool and doing important maintenance work to the outdoor pool.

The pool will reopen once we complete this work and we receive advice that it is safe to do so in accordance with the COVID-19 restrictions.

GRANT FUNDED PROJECTS

As the Australian and Victorian governments continue to make funding available to help the economy recover from the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, we're working hard to ensure Benalla Rural City benefits as much as possible. Only projects that meet grant criteria are eligible for funding, which is mostly around job creation and economic stimulus.
