Proposed changes to Nunn Street accessible (disabled) parking

The Council's CBD Parking Working Group is reviewing our parking bays to ensure they are compliant with the



revised Australian Standards for the Disability Discrimination Act 1992.

The four parking bays on Nunn Street, Benalla, require changes to conform to these standards which consider position, size and access to paths. It is proposed that the four non-compliant bays will be converted to two bays with enough circulation space for wheelchairs and walkers. The proposed parking bays will be centrally located between Bridge Street and Church Street.

We are seeking your input on the proposed changes to the accessible parking spaces on Nunn Street. We welcome all feedback, so please ensure you share this with those you feel may be impacted by the change.
