#### Digital Solutions program to roll out in Benalla

Benalla will host the Australian Small Business Advisory Service (ASBAS) Digital Solutions Program from 28 February to 23 October 2019.

The Council has partnered with Melbourne Innovation Centre (MIC) to offer the Australian Government's ASBAS Digital Solutions Program to businesses in Benalla. The Program offers small business operators workshops and mentoring on a range of digital solutions.

According to the Australian Digital Inclusion Index 2018, Benalla has the third lowest digital inclusion index in Australia. This means that businesses in Benalla aren't realising the social and economic benefits of being online.

This is an opportunity for small businesses to learn about the options provided by information technologies by receiving high quality, low cost training.

The training covers four priority areas:

- Websites and selling online
- Social media and digital marketing
- Using small business software
- Online security and data privacy

The program delivers group workshops, one-on-one mentoring, online training and webinars. Participants are provided with tailored digital engagement plans, a needs assessment and advisory support from mentors.

## Pet registrations due Monday 9 April

Are your pet's registration details up to date with the Council? If your cat or dog is registered and gets found, we can see who owns it and get in touch with you. Registrations are due by Monday 9 April. Make sure we have your correct address and phone number on record for your pet.

If a cat or dog is found that is not registered or microchipped, it is hard for us to found out who owns it. We hand the animal to the RSCPA in Wangaratta who then need to wait for the owner to get in contact.

The Domestic Animals Act 1994 requires all dogs and cats over the age of three months living in the municipality to be microchipped and registered with the Council. It is also a requirement that the issued registration tag be worn at all times.
