DID YOU KNOW?

In the 2016/17 year, the Council's **Planning** Unit:

- processed 96% of planning applications within the required 60 statutory days, against the state average of 62%.
- took an average of 21 days to process applications, against the state average of 83 days.

In the 2016/17 year, the Council's **Building** Unit:

- · received 189 Building Permits
- received 30 Building Notices and Orders
- conducted 565 building inspections
- oversaw 1 prosecution related to illegal building works

From April to June 2017 **business enquiries** received by the Council more than doubled to 81 compared with same time last year.
