DID YOU KNOW? TOURISM IN BENALLA RURAL CITY

- Over the last year, there were 335,000 visitors

Tourism and Events Strategy 2018-2022

Benalla Rural City's status as the arts and cultural epicentre of Victoria's high country is the highlight of a new tourism and events strategy.

Development of the Strategy has been overseen by representatives of Winton Wetlands, Winton Motor Raceway, Tourism North East and the Council, with input from more than 50 local tourism business operators.

The Strategy seeks to increase the Benalla Rural City annual visitor economy

from \$42m to \$58m per annum and create an extra 58 full-time jobs by 2022.

Some recommendations of the report can be implemented now for an immediate impact. Others are more visionary and long term, such as creating an arts precinct around the Lake.

The Council has begun the process of advertising the position of the Chief Executive Officer in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1989*.

PLANNING ON A DEVELOPMENT? HERE'S HOW

If you are planning to develop any land, such as building a new house or commercial enterprise, you'll be required to follow the planning application process.

1. Meet with Council staff and let them know about your plans
2. Submit a Planning Application along with all required supporting documents and drawings
3. Council staff refer your application to the relevant planning authorities
4. If required, your application will be advertised to adjoining properties
5. Objections to the application are received and assessed by Council staff in accordance with the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, *Sub-Division Act 1988* and *Benalla Planning Scheme*
6. Depending on the type and level of public interest and the scale of the development, the application

is either assessed by Council staff or presented to the Planning and Development Committee to make a recommendation to the Council

Planning and Development Committee

All seven Councillors are members of the Planning and Development Committee, which operates under strict rules. If a Councillor has a conflict of interest in any matter, the conflict is declared and the Councillor leaves the room.

All Councillors are equally involved in forming the recommendation of the Planning and Development Committee to the Council. The seven elected Councillors make up the Council.

If your application requires land to be rezoned, it will go through the Planning Scheme Amendment process which requires input from the State Government.
