Our *Proposed 2021/2022 Budget* has been released for public comment until Thursday 27 May.

Information in the proposed budget includes financial statements, a general description of the services and initiatives to be funded in the budget, major initiatives to be undertaken during the financial year and services to be funded by the budget.

The budget includes an \$11.18 million capital works program highlighted by a \$3 million upgrade to the Benalla Art Gallery and \$1.814 million to the Benalla Visitor Information Centre redevelopment.

FREE GREEN WASTE WEEKEND



Bring your green waste and dispose of it for free on our free green waste weekend at the Benalla Landfill and Resource Recovery Centre.

Saturday & Sunday 22-23 May 2021 Midday until 3.45pm

To access free green waste disposal, we ask that you make a trip with just organic (green) waste. You can bring up to 300kg per load. Some conditions apply:

- This is for domestic customers only so no trucks or tippers.
- · We can only accept raw timber in its natural form.
- Stumps need to be less than 400mm in diameter and 1000mm in length

MAIR STREET CARPARK
