You can continue to lend books from the Library. Order them online then pick them up. The Art Gallery also has some fantastic virtual exhibitions online.



## SWIMMING POOL REGISTRATIONS DUE

State Government laws require owners to register any pool or spa on their property by 1 June 2020.

This applies to all pools and spas capable of containing water deeper than 300mm (30cm).

## REGISTRATIONS NOW DUE

If your dog or cat is registered in Benalla Rural City, gets lost and needs returning to you, we can reunite you with it.

If this happens just once during the year, we'll return your pet for free.

Unregistered dogs and cats that leave their property are much more difficult to reunite with their families. If this happens, you'll need to pay a fee to have your pet returned and a fine for having an unregistered pet.

This year, we're issuing **Lifetime Tags**, so you won't have to get a new tag every year when you register your pet.

There are lots of ways to register your pet. Even though the doors to the Customer Service Centre are closed, you can still pay for your dog or cat registration.

## WINTON LURG SHOULDER UPGRADE

Winton Lurg Road has had its shoulder widened. The project included widening and sealing road shoulders for a distance of 2.94 kilometres and applying a final seal over the entire road.

The project has improved road safety for users. Now, two cars can pass simultaneously without having to pull aside onto the gravel shoulders.



## WORKS AROUND BENALLA RURAL CITY

We've completed drainage works at:

- · Goulding Close, Benalla
- · Gandini Lane, Lima East
- · Tulley Road, Lima East
- · Goorambat Chesney Road, Goorambat

We've replaced 75 metres of kerb and channel in Dunn Street, Benalla.

Approximately 70m<sup>2</sup> of footpath has been replaced across Benalla, including Carrier Street, Bridge Street, Wedge Street and Lowry Place.

We've cleaned drains around town to prepare for wet weather in Cowan Street and Maud Street.





# DID YOU KNOW? BENALLA AIRPORT REDEVELOPMENT

The Benalla Airport has had a \$1.6 million upgrade which is now complete. The Council project was made possible with contributions from the State and Federal Governments, Benalla Aviation Museum and Military Air Training Heritage Pty.

Improvements include:

- · Installation of modern fuel facility
- A water supply for firefighting purposes
- An extension to the hangar-access tarmac area
- An upgrade to the all-weather access tracks to the hangers
- The installation of signs and a safety fence
- New barriers around the fuel facility that meet Australian standards
- The construction of a longer glider strip
- The replacement of the main underground power supply
- The construction of a Code-A parallel taxiway
- The construction of an amenities building out on the airfield
- Modification and repairs to the storm water retention basins and drainage.

The project brings long-term tourism and business benefits to Benalla Rural City. In 2018-19, more than 3,000 visitors attended the Aviation Museum.

Our grader has been busy around Winton and Lurg, working on Greta Road, Sudholz Road, Ross Lane and Embling Road. We've also been grading roads around Tarnook at Goomalibee Road, Terrets Road, Basin Road and Four Mile Road.
