The Benalla Meals on Wheels service is in need of volunteers for Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Approximately 60 volunteers deliver more than 11,000 Meals on Wheels across Benalla every year. Providing delivered, nutritious meals helps people to remain living independently.

Volunteers are rostered to deliver meals from the Benalla Hospital to a designated route of between five and 10 homes. The route takes around one hour and gives recipients the chance to have a quick chat and a daily visitor to their door.

- There are approximately 1,000 rose bushes in the Benalla
 Botanical Garden, which were established in 1959. Volunteers
 prune the spent roses twice each week to keep the gardens looking
 their best and to extend the flowering of the plants.
- More than 8,900 street trees make up the Benalla township urban forest. Many of the street trees were planted in the 1930s and 1940s, including the various Elms which are a feature of the town.
