## MELBOURNE TO ALBURY LINE RECEIVES ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR UPGRADES

The Melbourne to Albury train line will receive \$135 million for upgrades on top of the original 2017 committment of \$100 million from the Federation Government.

Across Victoria, \$1.57 billion has been released for the Regional Rail Revival program and work is expected to start later in 2018.

With more reliable services, Benalla will be able to benefit more from its closeness to Melbourne, Wangaratta and Albury / Wodonga.

The funding is the result of lobbying by the Melbourne to Albury Passenger Rail Collaboration, which the Council is part of.

## Did you know...

- The Council oversees more than 40 accessible (disabled) parking bays across Benalla Rural City.


## VOLUNTEERING AT THE SIR EDWARD WEARY DUNLOP LEARNING CENTRE

The program, now in its second year, has trained more than 160 students and 50 adults in Mental Health First Aid
