

VicSmart - a new, streamlined planning permit assessment process

In March 2017, the State Government introduced an amendment to the planning permit assessment process. It is the responsibility of councils to enforce these processes. The new planning permit assessment process has a number of changes:

- Council now has five days to request further information instead of 28 days
- A decision must be made by the Council within 10 working days instead of 60 calendar days
- No notice is given to potentially affected parties and there are no third party appeal rights
- An application must be decided by the Chief Executive Officer or nominated delegate, not by the Council
- An applicant can apply to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT) for a review of a decision but this must be done within 10 business days, not the standard 60 calendar days.
